PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

The College is charged with the basic mission of producing leaders for various services and professions. The programme of education revolves around four components; Intellectual, Physical, Spiritual and Psychological. It was a year that saw Covid-19 fading away and college reverting to normal routine; ready to take new challenges and scaling new heights.

All the cadets who have shown merit in one respect or the other expect their names to be mentioned here. But this list will be rather too long and as such this report will restrict to major achievements.

Academic Excellence:

BISE Hyderabad:

I feel elated to share that the students of class SSC-I, who appeared for Secondary School Examination Part-I, passed the examination with flying colours. Out of 89 cadets, 86 secured A1 grade while 03 cadets clinched A grade. Cadet Sarosh kit# 19055 (SH) obtained A1 and stood first in the college by securing 94.36%.

This year cadets of HSC-I did very well in their annual examination by bringing well deserved results. 88 cadets appeared in the examination. 84 cadets secured A1 grade and 4 cadets obtained A grade. Cadet Mujtaba kit#17043 (J) clinched A1 grade and stood first by securing 93.64%.

The result of HSC-II was also significant as 117 cadets appeared for the annual examination and 115 cadets secured A1 grade and 02 cadets clinched A grade. Cadet M. Basit Azeem kit#19307 (L) obtained A1 grade and stood first in the college by securing exceptional percentage 97.73%

FBISE Islamabad:

Excellence in education and fostering the love of learning is the hall mark of Cadet College Petaro. I proudly mention that our cadets of class IX(SSC-I) from Federal Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education, Islamabad produced phenomenal results as our 58 cadets appeared in the examination, out of which 55 cadets secured A1 grades, 02 cadets A grade while 01 cadet B grade.

The result of SSC-II Annual Board Examination (FBISE, Islamabad) remained exceptionally well, 63 cadets appeared, and 55 cadets secured A1 grades.

In HSC-I of FBISE, Islamabad examination 62 cadets appeared, 27 cadet secured A1 grades, 21 cadets obtained A grade while 14 cadets clinched B grade. Cadet Huzaifa Javaid Kit# 17017 (A) stood first in the college by securing 94.42%.



Furthermore, the result of class XII (FBISE) is worth to mention. 32 cadets appeared in the examination. 09 cadets secured A1 grade and 20 obtained A grade and 02 cadets clinched B grade respectively. Cadet M. Shoaib-Ur-Rehman Kit#19302 (IQ) clinched first position in the college.

Cambridge System:

Cadet College Petaro sets new grade boundaries each time in the results of CAIE (Cambridge System) results by securing history's best results.

This year results of O level remained exceptional as 58 cadets secured A* and 40 A in all. Cadet Izaan Amir kit#C-19265 (SL) stood first in the college by securing 8 A*, Cadet Azzam Ahmed Sidhu Kit# C-19220 (A) obtained 07 A*, Cadet Asmir Imran Butt kit# C-19202 (A) clinched 07 A* and 02 A and Cadet Sarim Ahmed Siddiqui kit# C-19264 (SL) managed 04 * and 04 A.

In similar way, the result of class A-II remained up to mark. 11 cadets appeared in the CAIE examination. Cadet Bishar-ul-Asad clinched first position in the college by obtaining 06 A grades.

Confucius Classroom at CCP activities for the session of 2021-22

The role of Confucius Classroom at Cadet College Petaro is also exceptional as it gives cadets opportunity to learn Chinese language. 15th Chinese Language Bridge Competition was held on 20th April, 2022 at Confucius classroom at CCP. In which 09 cadets participated out of them 02 cadets, Cadet Hassan Riaz Kit#18049 (SH) and Cadet Umer Jamil kit# C-18048 (SL) shared 1st position.

Oxford University Press Book Review Competition

The subject contest was held in the month of February,2022 into two phases. It is matter of pride that Cadet Muhammad Jameel kit#20014 (MQ) was short listed for the 2nd Phase from the big number of students of whole South Region i-e Sindh and Balochistan and won the first position. While in second phase he received participation certificate.

Overall CCP won Basketball, Football, Hockey and Squash fixtures and won the friendly match fixture's trophy. CC Ormara won Cricket match fixture.

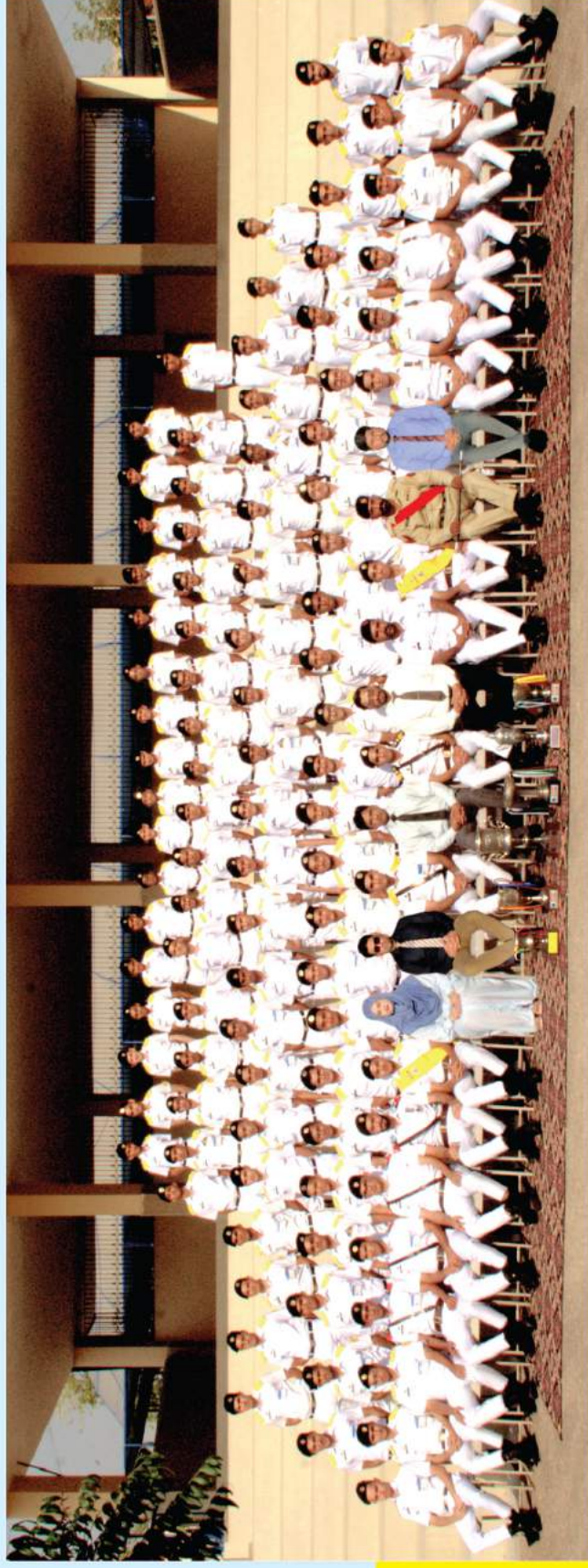

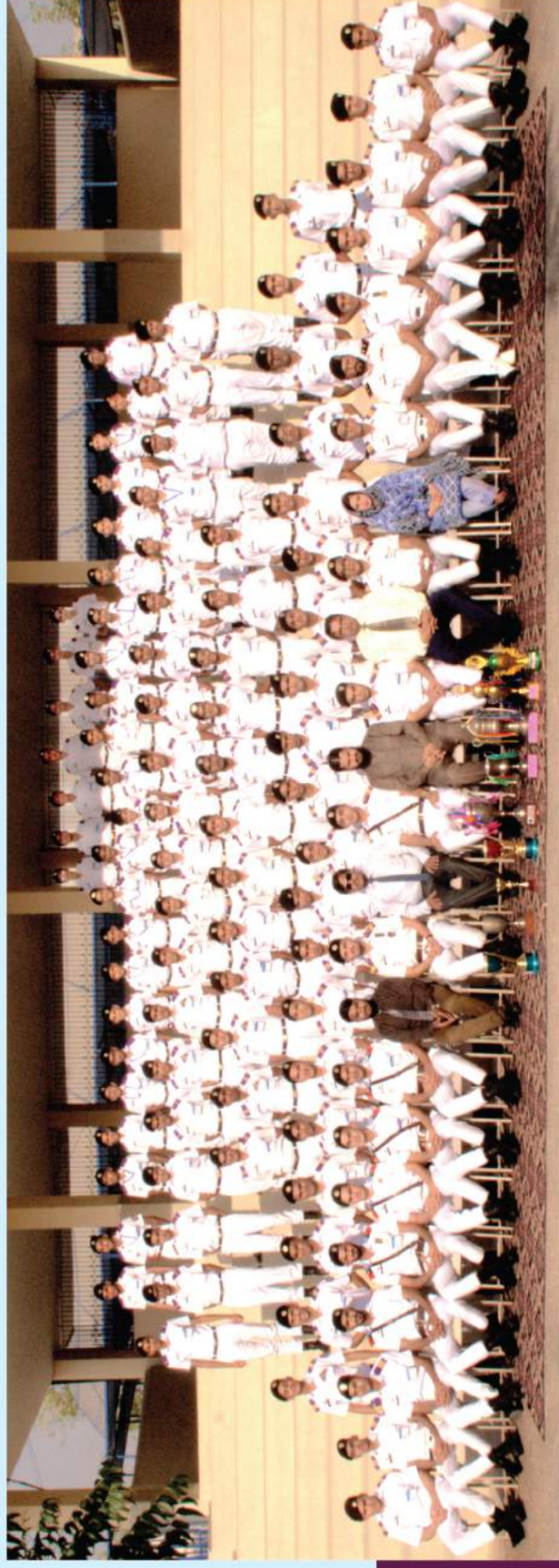

A global warming of more than 1.5 degrees Celsius will result in hitherto unheard-of climatic effects, such as larger and more violent storms, rainfall followed by longer and more severe droughts, etc. From one location to another, climate change differs.

From that day, she decided to make Pakistan leprosy free for her countryman. As the number of patients rose Ruth Pfau thought to adopt a new building on rent, paid by the German Relief Association. With the great struggle of Ruth Pfau and her team, WHO declared Pakistan a leprosy-free country in this region.

She once said:

"I have a love for the people of Pakistan. Pakistan is situated in my heart and I can feel its love with every beat of my heart"

In her last words, she guided the people of Pakistan that "work for humanity and live for forever".

Due to her restless effort, in 1969, the Government of Pakistan gave her the Quaid-e-Azam Gold medal.

On the 75 Independence Day celebration of Pakistan, the government installed QR Code at her grave so that people while visiting her, can scan it and receive and read the complete bio-data.

Paragliding is a world-famous sport that can make you experience flying on your own.

In paragliding, an individual is known as the paraglider who flies a parachute. The parachute plays the role of wings and is made of fabric, which has slits that allow the "Ram Air" effect. The "Ram-Air" effect is a term to describe the process of air inflating the parachute. Historically, the first instances of paragliding can be traced back to a Frenchman named PiesseLemoigne in the 1950s.

- **Requirements:**

1. Parachute with a span of 8-12 meters.
2. Suspending harness.

- **Competitions:**

Just like any other sport, people compete in paragliding too. The most famous competition is the world paragliding championship which is organized by "The Federation Aeronautique Internationale". The objective is race which entails the fastest glider to cross the finish line. The first ever championship was held in 1989 and the most recent one was in 2021.

- **Playing the Sports:**

To launch, the pilot first inflates the wing by pulling it up like a kite and then runs down the hillside until the flying speed has been 12 miles per hour (19 km per hour), which is enough to launch the craft. Paragliders may also be launched from flat land by towing, either with a winch or behind a vehicle.

- **Paragliding in Pakistan**

Paragliding was introduced in Pakistan mainly by European climbers in the 1980s when they visited the South Asian countries to scale some of the world's highest mountains. However, it was in 1990 that a Pakistani mountaineer, Jabbar Bhatti, demonstrated paragliding by flying in the northern areas as well as along the coastal belt of Sindh.

Our college, Cadet College Petaro gave this opportunity to cadets and arranged a trip to Abbottabad. So that cadets must experience paragliding and fulfill their fantasies.

In January 1950, Pakistan became the first nation in the Muslim world to recognize the People's Republic of China. On May 21, 1951, a diplomatic relationship was formed in the midst of the Bandung Conference. The first meeting between the two country's Presidents left a profound impression.

With regard to Pakistan's participation in the Central Treaty Organization (CENTO) and South East Asia Treaty Organization (SEATO), also known as the Baghdad Pact, the Chinese leadership demonstrated a surprising understanding.

With the signing of a border agreement and numerous other cooperation agreements in 1963, a new era in Pakistan-China relations was inaugurated. When US President Bill Clinton met with Chinese President Jiang Zemin in 1996 and asked him to halt military aid to Pakistan, the Chinese leader responded, "We Chinese have a tradition that when we drink water from a well, we always remember the one who dug the well," which proved to be a turning point as it heralded a new era of Sino-Pak strategic partnership.

Due to Pakistan's pivotal involvement in arranging Dr. Henry Kissinger's journey to China in 1971—a visit that ultimately helped influence the course of the twentieth century and the conclusion of the cold war with the fall of the Soviet Union-President Bill Clinton was unable to comment on the matter.

قرآن مجید میں ارشاد ہے کہ: ”پیغمبر ﷺ تمہیں کتاب و حکمت کے تعلیم دیتا ہے اور تمہیں وہ کچھ سکھاتا ہے جو تم نہیں جانتے۔ اللہ تعالیٰ کی رہنمائی میں رسول اکرم ﷺ ایک استاد کی حیثیت رکھتے ہیں اور صحابہ کرامؓ نے جو کچھ حضور اکرام ﷺ سے حاصل کیا اسے دوسروں تک پہنچانے کی ذمہ داری بڑے احسن طریقہ سے سرانجام دی۔

حدیث نبوی ﷺ:

اقبال نے کیا خوب کہا ہے

عروجِ آدمِ خاکی سے انجمِ سہمے جاتے ہیں
کہ یہ ٹوٹا ہوا تارِ امہِ کامل نہ بن جائے

الغرض علم ایک ایسا خزانہ ہے جس کو جتنا خرچ کیا جائے تو یہ اتنا ہی بڑھتا ہے۔ لہذا ہمیں چاہیے کہ ہم اپنا ہر پل علم حاصل کرنے میں صرف کریں اور علم کو دوسرے انسانوں کے لیے مفید بنائیں اور علم ہی ایک چشمہ ہے، جہاں پر کوئی بلا امتیاز اپنا حق حاصل کر سکتا ہے اور جہالت اور ظلمت کو دور کر کے اپنے علم کے نور سے منور کر سکتا ہے۔

علامہ اقبال اور قرآن

علامہ اقبالؒ کی شاعری اور پوری زندگی عشقِ رسول اور قرآنِ پاک سے عبارت ہے، آپ کی شاعری میں جا بجا قرآنِ پاک کا پیغام ملتا ہے، گویا آپ کی شاعری میں موجود تمام اشعار، قرآنِ پاک کی ہی تفسیر ہے۔ قرآن سے ہی تعلیمات مستعار لے کر علامہ اقبالؒ اپنی شاعری اور اقوال میں مسلمانوں کو حق کی تلقین کرتے نظر آتے ہیں۔ فرماتے ہیں کہ:

گر تُو می خواہی مسلمانِ زیستن
نیست ممکن جز بہ قرآنِ زیستن

(ترجمہ اگر تو مسلمان کی حیثیت سے زندگی گزارنا چاہتا ہے تو یہ قرآن کے بغیر ناممکن ہے)

دوسری گول میز کانفرنس میں شرکت سے قبل، لاہور سے روانہ ہو کر ۹ ستمبر ۱۹۳۱ء کو جب دہلی پہنچے تو ریلوے اسٹیشن پر آپ کا استقبال تقریباً تین ہزار لوگوں نے کیا۔ آپ نے اس مجمعے سے مختصر خطاب کرتے ہوئے فرمایا: ”جہاں تک سیاسی مسائل کا تعلق ہے میں آپ کو بتا دینا چاہتا ہوں کہ نہ میرے ساتھ کوئی پرائیویٹ سکیرٹری ہے، جو میرے لیے ضروری مواد فراہم کرے۔ نہ میرے پاس سیاسی لٹریچر کا کوئی پلندہ ہے جس پر میں اپنی بحثوں کی اساس قائم کروں، بلکہ میرے پاس حق و صداقت کی جامع کتاب (قرآن مجید) ہے جس کی روشنی میں مسلمانانِ ہند کے حقوق کی ترجمانی کرنے کی کوشش کروں گا۔“ (کتاب، اسفارِ اقبالؒ، صفحہ ۱۴۹)

”مارخور“ ہمارا قومی جانور

فارسی زبان میں مار ’سانپ‘ کو کہتے ہیں اور خور کا مطلب ہے کھانے والا۔ گلگت بلتستان میں مارخور کے بارے میں یہ تصور پایا جاتا ہے کہ یہ سانپ کو مار کر کھالیتا ہے۔ مارخور بلند و بالا پہاڑوں کے علاوہ تمام دیہی اور شہری علاقوں میں بھی کثرت سے پائے جاتے ہیں۔ یہ بات تو سب جانتے ہیں کہ مارخور پاکستان کا قومی جانور ہے لیکن شاید یہ کم لوگ جانتے ہوں گے کہ پاکستان کے اس قومی جانور کا شمار دنیا کے نایاب ترین جانوروں میں ہوتا ہے۔ مارخور کو یہ اعزاز حاصل ہے کہ یہ ان ۷۲ جانوروں میں شامل ہے جن کی تصاویر عالمی تنظیم برائے جنگلی حیات کے مطابق ۱۹۷۶ میں جاری کردہ سکہ جات کے مجموعہ میں شامل ہے۔ جنگلی بکرے کی خصوصیات کا حامل یہ خوبصورت جانور گلگت بلتستان کی ٹھنڈی فضاؤں کے علاوہ کشمیر، چرخیل اور کیلاش کی سرسبز وادیوں میں پایا جاتا ہے۔ پاکستان کے علاوہ یہ قیمتی اور کمیاب جانور بھارت، افغانستان، ازبکستان اور تاجکستان کے کچھ علاقوں میں بھی پایا جاتا ہے۔ ایک اندازے کے مطابق دنیا میں بالغ مارخور کی تعداد ۲۵۰۰ سے بھی کم ہے۔ مارخور پہاڑی علاقوں میں رہنا پسند کرتا ہے اور ۶۰۰ سے ۳۶۰۰ میٹر بلندی تک پایا جاسکتا ہے۔ اس قدر وقامت میں نمایاں اس کے مضبوط اور مڑے ہوئے سینگ ہیں، جن کی لمبائی ۱۴۳ سینٹی میٹر ہو سکتی ہے۔ جب کہ اس کا وزن ۱۰۴ کلوگرام تک ہوتا ہے۔ اس کی اونچائی ۱۰۲ سینٹی میٹر تک ہوتی ہے مارخور کی تین اقسام مشہور ہیں جن میں استور مارخور، بخارائی مارخور اور کابلی مارخور شامل ہے۔

مارخور پاکستان کی انٹیلی جنس ایجنسی ’آئی ایس آئی‘ کا نشان بھی ہے۔ مقامی لوگ کہانیوں کے مطابق مارخور سانپ مار کر چب جاتا ہے اور اس کے منہ سے جھاگ نکلتا ہے جو نیچے گر کر خشک اور سخت ہو جاتا ہے اور جس سے سانپ کے کانٹے پر تریاق کے طور پر استعمال کیا جاتا ہے۔

قدرت اور قدرتی وسائل کے تحفظ کی عالمی تنظیم نے مارخور کو ایسے جانوروں کے صف میں شمار کیا ہے۔ جن کا وجود خطرے میں ہے یعنی ان کی حفاظت کے لیے مناسب اقدامات اٹائے نہیں گئے تو مستقبل قریب میں یہ نسل کرہ ارض سے ہمیشہ کے لیے نایاب ہو سکتی ہے

نظریہ اضافیت

آج کے دور میں آئن اسٹائن کا پیش کردہ ”نظریہ اضافیت“ کسی تعارف کا محتاج نہیں سائنس کا ہر طالب علم اس سے بخوبی واقف ہے لیکن ابتداء میں جب یہ نظریہ پیش کیا گیا تو لوگ آئن اسٹائن سے بھی ناواقف تھے۔ آئن اسٹائن اپنا یہ نظریہ پیش کرنے کے لیے امریکہ کی مختلف اور دور دراز درسگاہوں میں اپنے ڈرائیور کے ہمراہ جایا کرتے تھے۔ ایسے ہی جب ایک مرتبہ آئن اسٹائن اپنا مذکورہ نظریہ پیش کرنے کے لیے ایک ایسی یونیورسٹی میں جا رہے تھے جہاں کے لوگ آئن اسٹائن کو نہیں جانتے تھے اور نہ انھوں نے ان کی کوئی تصویر دیکھ رکھی تھی۔ دوران سفر آئن اسٹائن کے ڈرائیور نے ان کہا کہ سر میں نے آپ کا ہر لیکچر سن رکھا ہے اب میں بھی اس پر بات کر سکتا ہوں۔ آپ کی اجازت ہو تو اس دفعہ لیکچر میں دے دوں۔ چونکہ لوگ نہ آپ کو جانتے ہیں نہ مجھے لہذا کوئی دقت بھی نہ ہوگی۔ یونیورسٹی پہنچنے تک آئن اسٹائن ڈرائیور اور ڈرائیور آئن اسٹائن بن چکے تھے۔ لیکچر ہوا اور ڈرائیور نے نظریہ اضافیت بخوبی پیش کیا لیکن وہ یہ بھول گیا کہ ہر لیکچر کے آخر میں سوال و جواب کا دور ہوتا ہے۔ ڈرائیور حاضر دماغ تھا بلکل بھی نہیں گھبرایا۔ پہلا سوال ہوا تو ڈرائیور نے کمال مہارت سے جواب دیا آپ کی یونیورسٹی کا معیار اتنا اچھا نہیں آپ لوگ اتنے آسان سوال کرتے ہیں کہ ان کا جواب میرا ڈرائیور بھی دے سکتا ہے۔ ڈرائیور یعنی آئن اسٹائن کے جواب کے بعد مزید کوئی سوال ہی نہیں ہوا۔

سیارے اور ستارے میں فرق

نظام شمسی ایک اشار سسٹم ہے۔ جس کے مرکز میں سورج جیسا ستارہ موجود ہے اور اس کے گرد سیارے گھومتے ہیں۔ یعنی ہماری زمین ایک سیارہ ہے اور ہمارا سورج ایک ستارہ ہے۔

کائنات میں اور ہماری کہکشاں (ملکی وے) میں سورج سے لاکھوں گنا بڑے ستارے موجود ہیں۔

ستارے دراصل ہائیڈروجن اور ہیلیم گیس کے بنے ہوتے ہیں۔ ایک عمومی ستارے میں ہائیڈروجن کے دو ایٹم مل کر ہیلیم کا ایک ایٹم بناتے ہیں اور اس عمل کو فیوژن کہتے ہیں۔ اس عمل کے ذریعے کچھ مادہ توانائی میں تبدیل ہوتا ہے۔ یہ توانائی روشنی اور تابکاری کی صورت میں ستاروں سے نکلتی ہے۔ یہ روشنی فیوژن کے عمل سے پیدا ہوتی ہے۔

زمین ایک سیارہ ہے۔ ہمارے علاوہ نظام شمسی میں اور بھی سیارے موجود ہیں، جو عموماً ستارے یعنی سورج کے گرد گھوم رہے ہیں۔ سیاروں کی اپنی کوئی روشنی نہیں ہوتی، کیوں کہ ان میں ستاروں کی طرح کوئی فیوژن کا عمل نہیں ہوتا۔ لہذا سیارے، ستاروں سے روشنی حاصل کرتے ہیں۔ کائنات میں کئی ایسے نظام شمسی ہیں جن کے مرکز میں ایک ستارہ ہے، اور ان کے گرد سیارے گھوم رہے ہیں۔

حضرت ابو عبیدہ بن جرحؓ

حضرت ابو عبیدہ بن جرحؓ کا خاندان اصل میں مکہ کا رہائش پذیر تھا۔ جہاں پر عام الفیل سے گیارہ برس بعد آپؓ کی ولادت ہوئی۔ مکہ میں ہی آپ پلے بڑھے۔ اسلامی تاریخ میں حضرت ابو عبیدہ بن جرحؓ اپنی کنیت 'ابو عبیدہ' کے نام سے مشہور ہیں۔ آپؓ کا اصل نام عامر بن عبد اللہ بن جرح بن ہلال تھا۔ آپؓ کا تعلق قریش کی شاخ 'بنو قیس' سے تھا۔ جب کہ آپؓ کی والدہ 'بنو حارث' سے تھیں۔ بعثت نبوی ﷺ کے اعلان کے وقت آپؓ اٹنیس سال کے نوجوان تھے۔ جوانی کے جوش اور آزادانہ ماحول کے باوجود جب حضرت ابو بکرؓ کے ذریعے اسلام کا آفاقی پیغام آپؓ تک پہنچا تو بنا کسی تردد کے فوراً اسلام لے آئے اور سب سے پہلے اسلام مقبول کرنے والے آٹھ لوگوں کے بعد آپ کا شمار ہوتا ہے۔ آپؓ نہایت سادہ کھاتے اور اوڑھتے تھے۔ آپؓ کو اسلامی لشکر اور شام کی ولایت سنبھالنے کے عہدے بھی ملے۔ تاہم آپؓ قناعت و زہد پر ان چیزوں کا کوئی اثر نہیں ہوا۔ حضرت عمر فاروقؓ کے زمانے میں جب آپؓ شام و فلسطین کی مہم پر گئے اور لشکر کے سپہ سالار تھے تو ایک دن حضرت عمر فاروقؓ آپؓ کے خیمہ میں آ پہنچے تو وہاں تلوار اور ڈھال کے علاوہ کوئی اور سامان موجود نہیں تھا تو حضرت عمرؓ نے فرمایا: اے ابو عبیدہ! ضرورت کا کچھ سامان تو اپنے پاس رکھ لیا کرو۔ اس وقت آپؓ نے جواب دیا، اے امیر المؤمنین! "ہماری یہی (سادگی) حالت ہمیں بہت جلد ہماری آسائش گاہ تک پہنچا دے گی"

دوسری مرتبہ فلسطین کی فتح کے بعد جب حضرت عمرؓ آپؓ کے دولت خانے پر کھانے کے لئے تشریف لائے تو آپؓ نے امیر المؤمنینؓ کے سامنے سوکھی روٹی کے کچھ ٹکڑے رکھے جو وہ خود بھی تناول فرماتے تھے۔ اس وقت امیر المؤمنینؓ نے فرمایا: "شام میں آ کر سب ہی بدل گئے لیکن ابو عبیدہ ایک تم ہی ہو جو اپنی وضع پر قائم ہو۔"

ہجرت کے نویس سال جب یمن کی طرف سے علاقے کے چند اہل کتاب حاضر ہوئے اور ناکام ہو کر بلا خر جزیہ آپ ﷺ کو دینے پر آمادہ ہوئے تو انہوں نے عرض کیا: یا رسول اللہ ﷺ! آپ ہمارے اوپر جو بھی جزیہ مقرر فرمائیں گے ہم وہ ادا کریں گے۔ آپ ہمارے ساتھ ایک امین آدمی بھیجیں۔ تو آپ ﷺ نے حضرت ابو عبیدہؓ کا ہاتھ پکڑ کر فرمایا: "یہ اس امت کا امین ہے۔"

آخری دنوں میں مسلمانوں کی فوجی چھاؤنی فلسطین کے نواحی علاقے "عمواس" میں تھی۔ اچانک طاعون کی وبا پھیلنے شروع ہوئی۔ حضرت ابو عبیدہؓ کے مشورہ سے حضرت عمر فاروقؓ نے اس لشکر کو دمشق کے قریب جولان علاقے میں "جابیہ" کی طرف منتقل کر دیا۔ تاہم وبا کے اثرات اتنے پھیلے کہ ہزاروں مسلمان فوجی شہید ہو گئے۔ جن میں حضرت ابو عبیدہؓ بن جرح بھی تھے۔ آپؓ ۱۸ ہجری کو ۵۹ برس کی عمر میں اس دار فانی سے کوچ کر گئے۔

کیا آپ نے کبھی اپنے اردگرد لوگوں کی ناکامی پر غور کیا ہے؟ کیا آپ نے سوچا ہے کہ اکثر لوگ کامیاب ہونے کے کچھ عرصہ بعد ہی دوبارہ اسی خستہ حالت میں کیوں لوٹ آتے ہیں؟ اگر نہیں سوچا تو اب سوچیں ہمارے اردگرد لوگوں کی ناکامی کی وجوہات بہت ملی جلی سی ہیں ہم میں سے اکثر لوگ خود کو کم تر اور کمزور سمجھتے ہیں، اور یہی یہ اپنی سوچ پر اتنا پختہ یقین ہوتا ہے کہ وہ کچھ مثبت سوچ ہی نہیں پاتے۔ بچپن سے بڑھاپے تک انہیں دوسروں پر انحصار کرنے کی عادت ہو جاتی ہے۔ ان افراد کو کوئی کام دیا جائے تو ان کا پہلا تاثر ہوتا ہے کہ وہ یہ کام نہیں کر سکتے۔ یہ کہنا کہ مجھ سے نہیں ہو گا یا میں نہیں کر سکتا گناہ خود ایک بہت بڑی ناکامی ہے۔ اور اس سے ہی انسان پر ناکامی کے دروازے کھلتے چلے جاتے ہیں۔ اکثر ہم خود کو کسی کام کے قابل نہیں سمجھتے اور اپنے دل و دماغ میں یہ وہم بٹھا لیتے ہیں کہ ہم تو ہیں ہی ناکام، کامیاب کیسے ہو سکتے ہیں؟ یہ وہم کہ میں کچھ نہیں کر سکتا گا ہم سے آگے بڑھنے کا حوصلہ چھین لیتا ہے ہم باصلاحیت ہونے کے باوجود خود کو کمتر محسوس کرتے ہیں اور ہماری یہ عادت ہم پر کامیابی کے دروازے بند کر دیتی ہے۔ ایسا ممکن ہے کہ کوئی کام آپ کو واقعی نہیں آتا لیکن اختیار تو آپ کے پاس ہی ہے۔ ایک بار محنت کرنے پر اگر کامیابی نہ ملے تو دوسری بار بہتر طریقے سے محنت کی جائے۔ اگر پھر بھی کامیابی حاصل نہ ہو تو اپنے کام میں موجود خامی کو تلاش کیا جائے اور مسلسل محنت کی جائے۔ کام کے لائق ہو جائیں گے اور ایک دن آئے گا جب آپ اپنے اپنے کام میں ماہر ہو جائیں گے۔ کوشش ترک کر دی جائے تو انسان کھوکھلا ہو کر رہ جاتا ہے۔ آخر کیا وجہ ہے کہ سب انسان ایک ہونے کے باوجود کامیابی اور ناکامی کی تفریق کا شکار ہیں۔ میں سمجھتا ہوں کہ اس معاملے میں بنیادی فرق جذبے اور تڑپ کی کمی ہے۔ جو لوگ کامیابی حاصل کرتے ہیں وہ خود بھی تڑپ اور کامیابی کا جذبہ رکھتے ہیں۔ اور جنہیں ناکامی سے دوچار ہوتے ہیں اس میں سارا قصور ان کا اپنا ہوتا ہے۔ ایسے افراد اگر خود کو یہ یقین دلوانے میں کامیاب ہو جائیں کہ اللہ نے ان کو اشرف المخلوقات بنا کر بھیجا ہے تو یقیناً ان کے لئے اپنے آپ میں کامیابی کا جذبہ پیدا کرنا آسان ہو جائے گا۔ دنیا میں کچھ بھی ناممکن نہیں ہے بس انسان کو اپنا عزم اور حوصلہ بلند رکھنے کی ضرورت ہے۔
